

The Supply Zone for Teachers, a service of Brevard Schools Foundation, is a nonprofit resource center that provides free school supplies for teachers to use in high-poverty classrooms in Brevard County, Florida. Shopping at the Supply Zone is a privilege and is contingent upon certain criteria, listed below.

School Participation Policies

- Supply Zone eligibility is determined by a school's Free/Reduced Lunch Level as reported on the
 most recently released FTE Survey III Free and Reduced Lunch Report issued by the Florida
 Department of Education.
- When the Supply Zone has the capacity to add new schools into the program, those schools will be added in order of highest Free/Reduced Lunch percentages according to the most recently released FTE Survey III Free and Reduced Lunch Report.
- As long as a school's FTE Survey III Free and Reduced Lunch percentage remains above 70%, that school will continue to be served by the Supply Zone, even if another non-participating school experiences an increase in Free/Reduced Lunch numbers beyond an original school.
- If a participating school's FTE Survey III Free and Reduced Lunch percentage drops below 70%, that school will be removed from the program in order to make room for a new school with more than 70% Free/Reduced Lunch.
- All teachers who choose to shop at the Supply Zone are required to view our shopping policies
 before they come (shopping policies are emailed to teachers at the beginning of every school
 year and included in every shopping date reminder email). Shopping privileges may be revoked
 for abuse of our policies or for other infractions. We reserve the right to share a teacher's
 shopping information with his or her school administrator(s).
- Occasionally, the Supply Zone may host special events for a limited number of teachers. These
 types of events usually require an RSVP with a list of name(s) from each school's principal or
 other administrator. Emails will be sent directly to principals while cc'ing school secretaries.
 Please be sure to respond to these emails in a timely manner. If you do not wish to have the
 Supply Zone communicate directly with the principal for these matters, you will need to provide
 an alternate name as the point of contact.
